Description:

This is a short video making project. All participants are invited to record, in their most creative way, a short video (as short as you like but no longer than 40 seconds), and send it to KildareYouthTheatre@gmail.com

You can make one video per prompt below.

- 1. Kildare Youth Theatre
- 2. A plague on both your houses (Romeo and Juliet)
- 3. Why I perform
- 4. These days, these nights
- 5. Push the RED button

The prompt is there to start off your creative thinking. The video need not refer to it. It can be as loosely inspired by the prompt as you wish.

You may also upload your video to your own social media platform. However, if you are under 18 you must show it to your parents first and edit it if they request you to, or not upload it if they ask you to. It should only be uploaded to your social media if you have their consent. Important: Please use the hashtag #CrookedHouseStaysAtHome when you post. Send us a link to the video wherever you post it.

All videos will be judged, and some will be chosen to be edited together to make one short public video on one of those prompts. If your video is chosen then we will need parental permission for us to use it if you are under 18.

How to take part:

- 1. Make a video (or one per subject).
- 2. Show it to your parents and get their approval to upload and send it.
- 3. Upload it to your preferred social media platform
- 4. Then, email the video to <u>KildareYouthTheatre@gmail.com</u> or share it using Google Drive if it is too big to email. Also email us the link to the video on social media.

Just emailing a link to social media may not work for us as we may not have access to see your video, so that's why we ask you to email the video as well.

Who can take part?

Any registered member of Kildare Youth Theatre aged 11 or over.

Guidelines for participants:

- Videos should not contain images of children or family members (they may be off-screen, or be filmed in clearly unidentifiable ways if necessary). They may be heard, if necessary.
- Please show the finished video to your parents before you send it. They need to approve that the content is ok for us to see, and perhaps to upload publicly.
- Avoid graphic content, sexualised images, inappropriate language or content, and anything you would be embarrassed by in weeks to come.
- Consider not filming anything that identifies your property of that of your family.
- If anyone has any questions please feel free to email <u>info@crookedhouse.ie</u> or WhatsApp 087 2759420. Use the Gmail address to send the video.
- Use your phone's camera. However, if you want to use another camera do.
- Strict time limit of 40 seconds for the video.
- If you want to use music, do so, but we might be restricted from including it in the final compilation due to copyright issues.

Timeline:

The deadline to submit finished videos is Tuesday, 24th March at 7.00pm. Winning videos will be selected, and a compilation made. This compilation will be posted online on our website and social media on Saturday 28th March.

Prize:

The 3 overall winning videos will receive a €10 book token each.
