Digital Photo Competition



Description:

The Digital Photography project will follow a competition format. The way it will work is that each day the participants will receive 3 prompts. The prompts can be anything – visual, audio or a quote/ line from a play or movie. It may be changed every day, so for example one day we might send you a photograph and ask you to interpret and recreate it using your own ideas and vision and the next we may send you a short story and ask you to represent/tell that story using one single photo. The participants will then take photographs using these prompts and submit them to the official Digital Photography competition Instagram page @crookedhousephoto or alternatively to KildareYouthTheatre@gmail.com if you don't have Instagram.

At the end of each day, we will choose the best of all photographs submitted in each category and will post them on the Instagram page. The participants will be given the prompts the night before and will have until 5.30pm the next day to complete the tasks.

How to take part:

All you have to do to take part is message us on Instagram on the @crookedhousephoto page with your name, age and a single line of text as to why you'd like to take part. Alternatively, you may do this by email to <u>KildareYouthTheatre@gmail.com</u> Please add "Digital Photography Competition" to the subject line in your email. You will then receive prompts through either Instagram or your email depending on preference. The prompts will also be displayed on the page's Instagram story every morning.

Guidelines for participants:

- Please do not submit sensitive content such as nudity or any sort of violence.
- As well as this, be aware of people's privacy if you are including them in an image and do not include anybody's face or body in it. Hands and legs are okay.
- If it is a photo which you are in, that's okay as long as it follows the above rules regarding content.

Timeline:

The deadline to sign up is Wednesday 18th March. On Thursday, 19th March the prompts will begin. There will be a final selection of the best three pictures from all those submitted. This will take place during the Quarantine Festival on Sunday, 29th March.

Permissions required (parents):

Please run each photo by your parents to make sure that it is appropriate for submission, taking care that privacy or personal space is not violated.

Who can take part?

Any registered member of Kildare Youth Theatre aged 11 to 24.

Prizes:

The overall top three photos will win a $\in 10$ book token for their photographer.
