Description:

How to take part:

- 1. Email us on <u>KildareYouthTheatre@gmail.com</u> expressing interest in taking part in Social Distance.
- 2. Create your own podcast (through the recording platform of your choice) about whatever you wish.
- 3. Send all recorded podcasts to us.
- 4. A selection of podcasts will be uploaded to our website on Saturday, 28th March.

Guidelines for participants (including ethical things to be aware of):

- Please show the finished recording to your parents before you send it. They need to approve that the content is ok for us to hear, and perhaps to upload publicly.
- Avoid graphic content, inappropriate language or content, and anything you would be embarrassed by in weeks to come.
- Check out https://anchor.fm/ a tool that helps you make podcasts and even interview people not in the same space as you.

Timeline:

Register your interest through email by the 20th of March, alongside the name of the podcast, and what it is about/what it discusses.

Recordings should be finished and sent to us by the 24th of March.

All recordings deemed eligible will be uploaded to a platform by the conclusion of the project, 28th of March.

Who can take part?

Any registered member of KYT over the age of 11.

Prizes:

The top three podcasts will be awarded book tokens of €10 during the Quarantine Festival on Sunday, 29th March.
